Activity-I: Swach Bharath



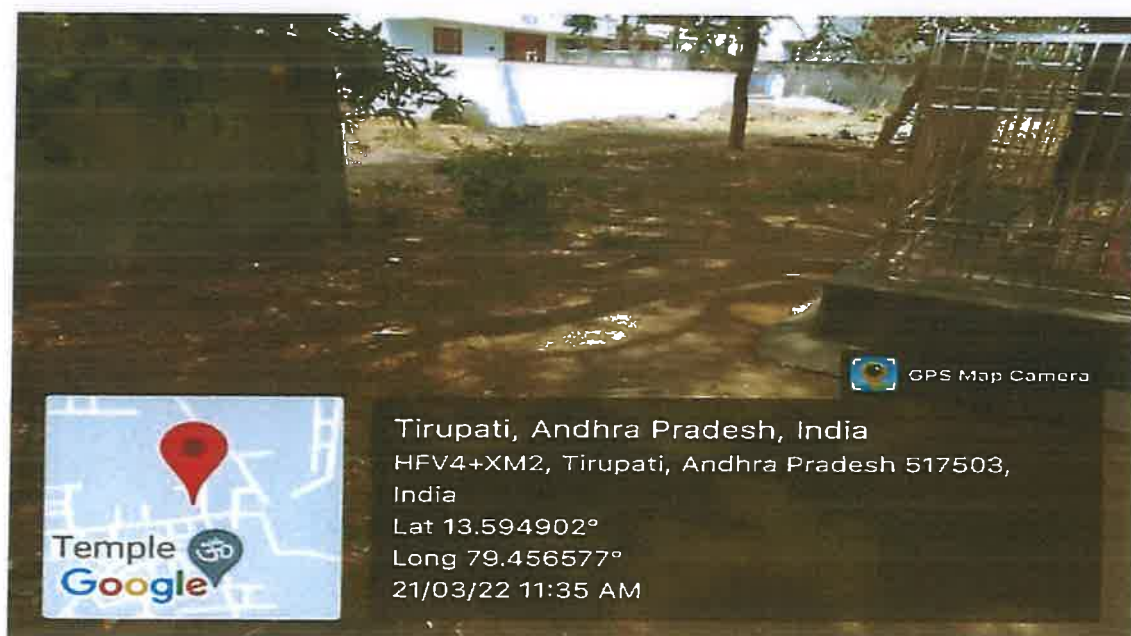
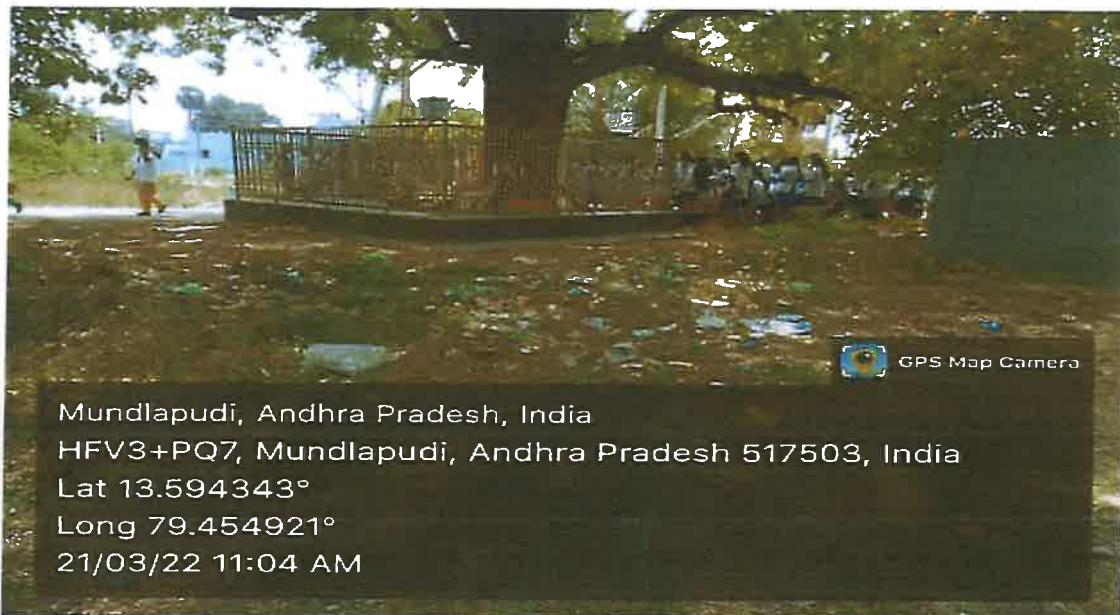
Objectives:

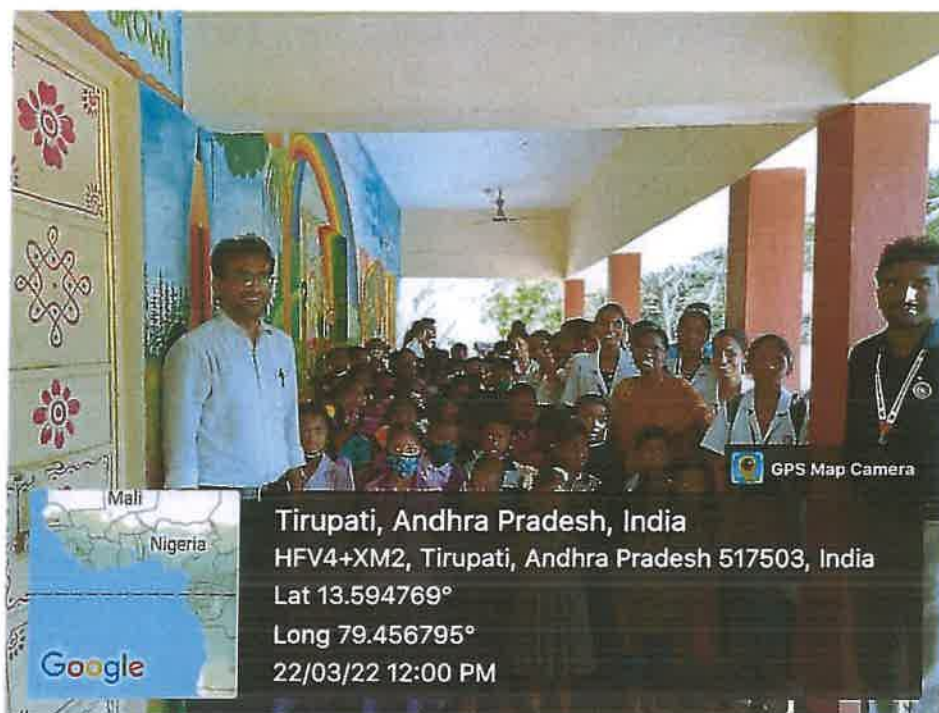
Impact: The villagers understood the significance of maintenance of clean and tidy environment for the neat and healthy life. Volunteers understood the process of maintenance of a clean environment.

Activity-I: Work shop on power yoga, body work outs, drawing, hand crafting, women safety and education on good and bad touch

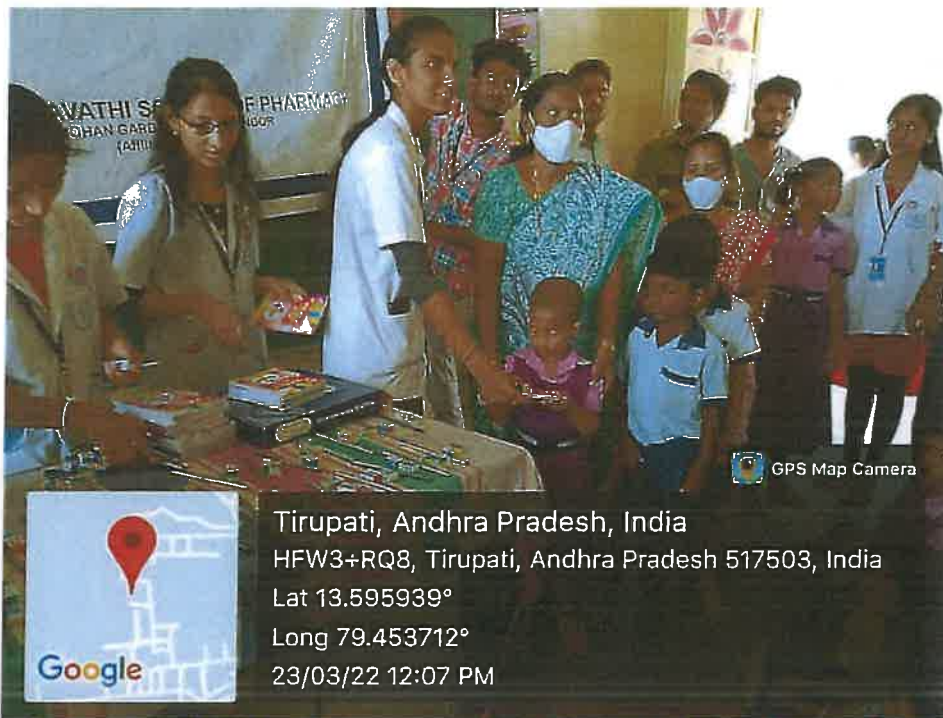
Objectives:

Activity-I: House to house awareness on water conservation

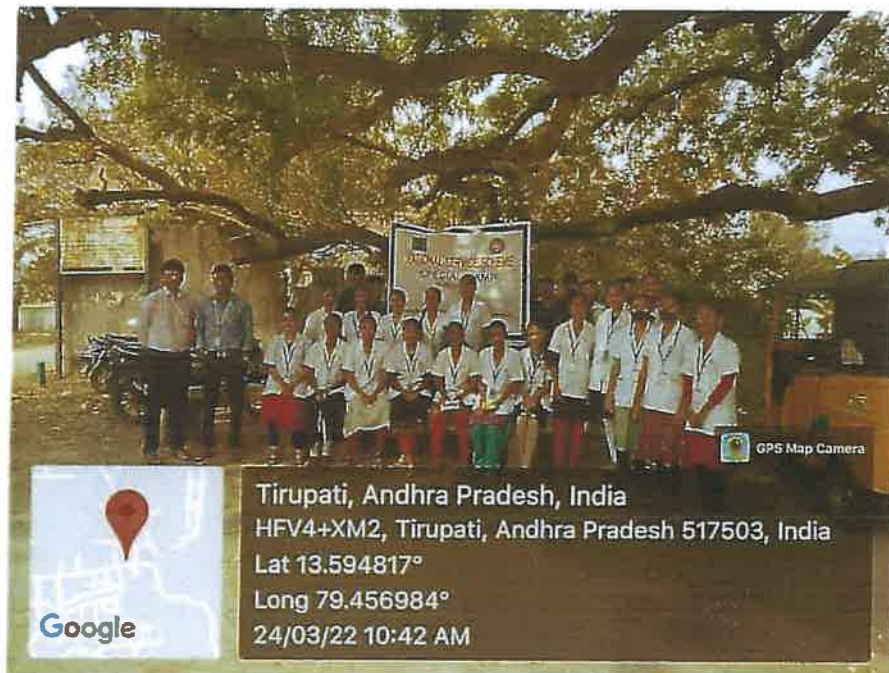

Activity-I: House to house awareness on water conservation and clinical support

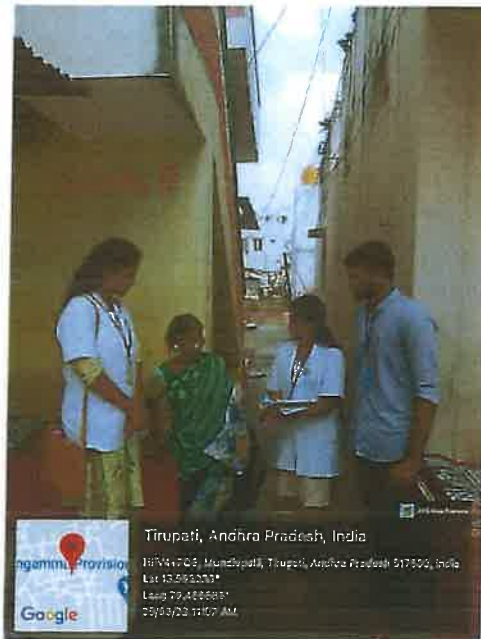
Objectives:
