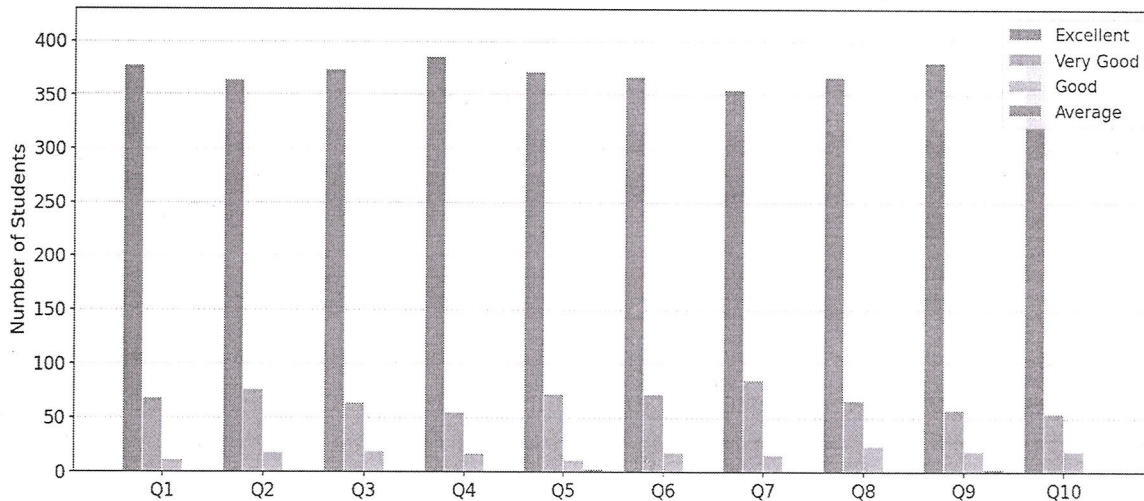

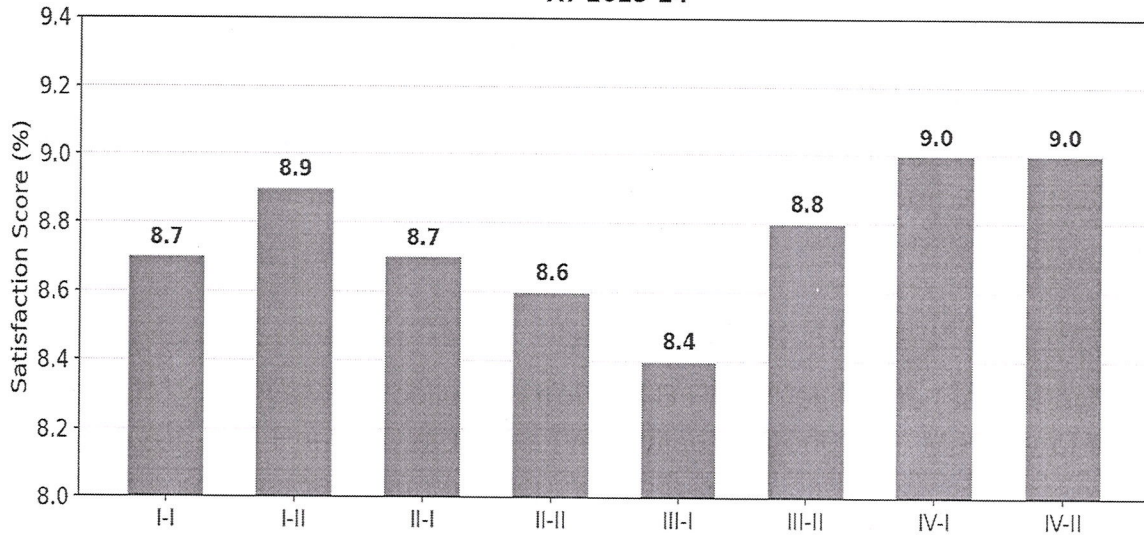
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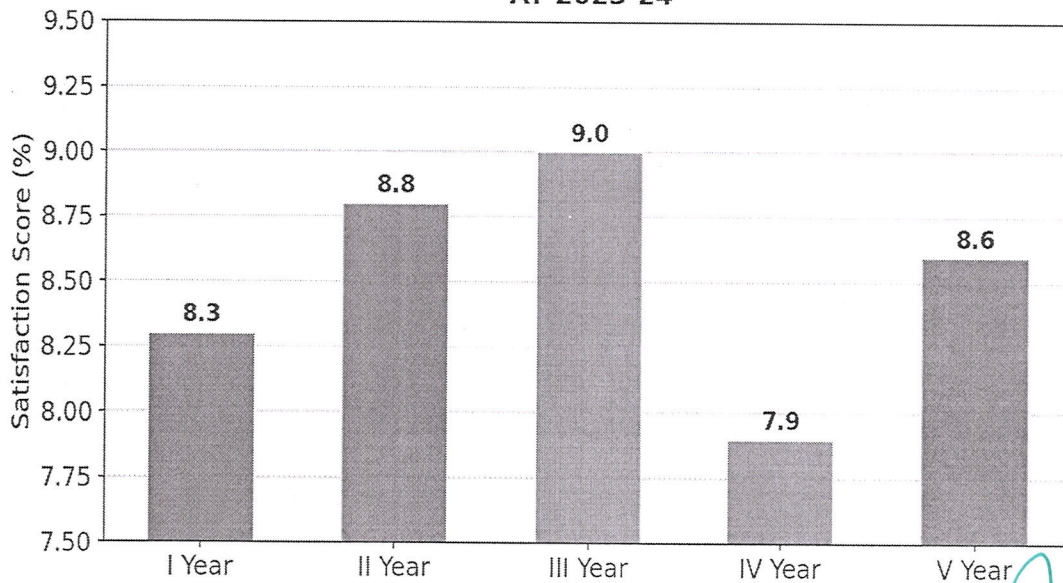
Course End Survey (CES) – Satisfaction Scores

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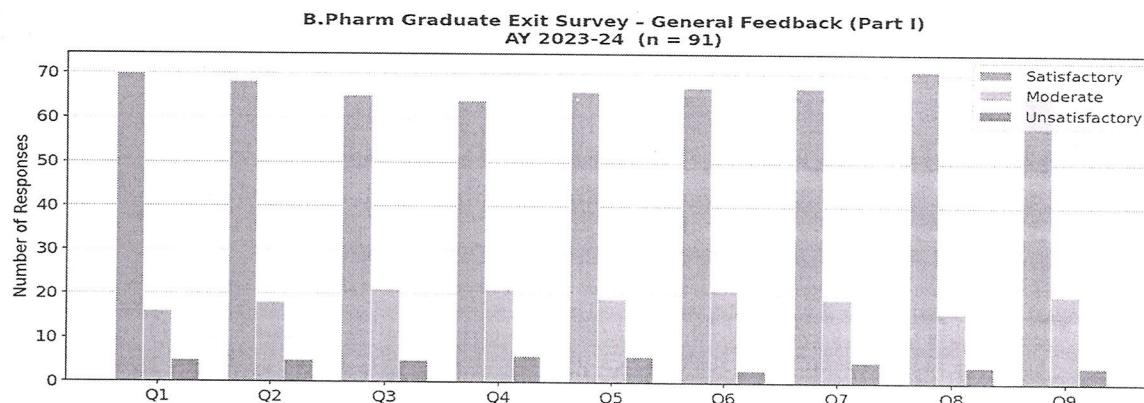


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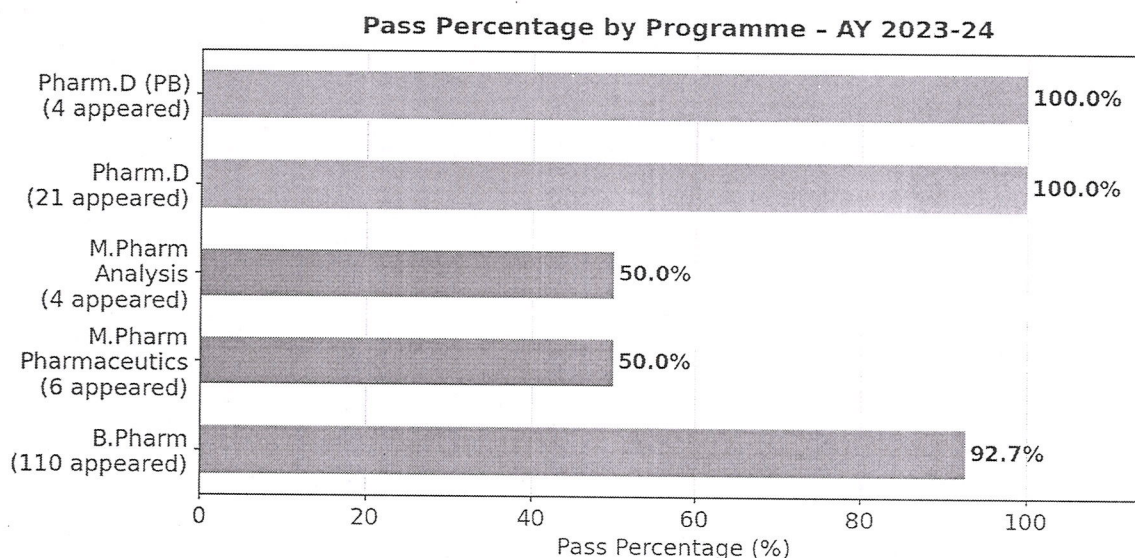
Graduate Exit Survey (GES) – Outgoing Students

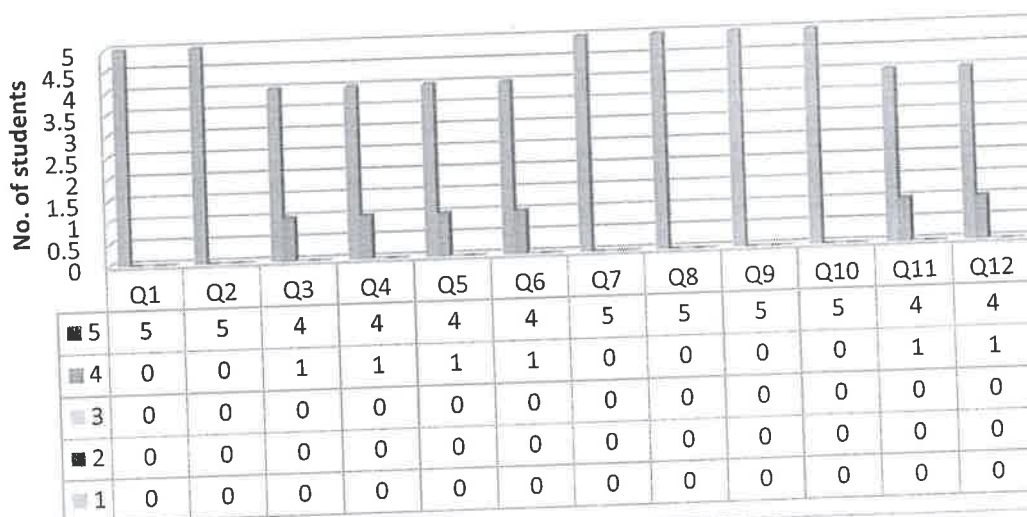
